Dear Parents/Carers

We have recently noticed an increase in the number of COVID cases in the local area, as well as in our school community. Please be mindful if your child is feeling unwell or is experiencing symptoms such:

- mild upper respiratory tract symptoms such as a congested or runny nose, sneezing, or a scratchy or sore throat
- cough with no difficulty breathing
- not drinking as much fluid (such as water) as usual in the last 24 hours
- mild vomiting and diarrhea (fewer than 4 times in the last 24 hours)
- mild headache or body aches
- mild fever
- mild fatigue

Please ensure that you test your child and do not send them to school if they are unwell. If they test positive it is recommended that they isolate for 5 days and do not return to school until they are symptom free.

This will be drawn at the Family Christmas Picnic.




EILDON CHURCH FOOD DRIVE
